1. Log on: <http://levy.restaurant.org/>

2. Enter the Password: **LEVY**

3. Enter your personal information and employment history.

4. Choose **WI - Lambeau Field** from the drop down list.

5. Choose **Non-Profit** from the drop down list.

Read all materials and click **Next** to go to next page. You will then be able to take the test.

Once you have completed the test and you submit your answers, it will ask for the manager's / supervisor's e-mail address. Please enter:

Send a cc to mbushman@new.rr.com so the Knights have a record. The results will be e-mailed back to [Levy] and will be printed as proof you completed the online training. Please keep in mind that if you don't enter the e-mail addresses above the results will not be sent to us.

The online class does not have a location for you to enter your group name, so in order for us to make sure your group receives proper credit for the
